MISSION

Obtain properly trained and safe contractor workforce and eliminate redundant orientations by providing consistent cost effective reciprocal safety education.

OVERVIEW

TSISC was created as a not-for-profit organization to address the need for uniform and consistent orientation of contract workers in local industry. TSISC currently has several members within the organization and anticipates continued growth.

TSISC has two specific orientation programs that are taught through the University of Southern Indiana (USI), Basic Orientation Plus™ (BOP) and Basic Orientation Plus-Refresher™ (BOPR).

BASIC ORIENTATION PLUS™ (BOP)

The Basic Orientation Plus reciprocal contractor safety awareness orientation program was designed to enhance safety.

The program is not meant to relieve contract companies of training responsibilities. There are elements of the standards that require the contractor to provide employer specific information regarding policy and procedures as well as some hands-on training on specific equipment.

BASIC ORIENTATION PLUS-REFRESHER™ (BOPR)

The Basic Orientation Plus-Refresher is an annual overview program that takes approximately four hours to complete. This orientation may be taken annually after successful completion of BOP.

- General Rules & Emergency Response
- Job Hazard Analysis (JHA)
- Confined Space

After completion of the classroom orientation (six hours) a validated test composed of 50 questions is administered and must be successfully completed to earn the ARSC/TSISC badge.
